Mohd Bohori Bin Che Makhtar, born in Kelantan Malaysia, is a Merdeka boy that gifted as bonsai Master for Malaysia. He started making bonsai in 1993, about 30 years ago, and introducing the infamous Cucur Atap (*Beackea frutescens*) till today, it is a champion species that represents Malaysia's treasure in the tropical species of Bonsai. Over the years, he has nearly 500 collection of various bonsai trees nearing completion and new reporting consists of ext *Premna*, *Beackea Frutescens*, *buxus*, *Maba Buxifolia*, *Wrightia Religiosa*, *Hisbiscus*, *triphasia Tripholia*, *Murraya paniculata*, *Ficus* ect. *ficus* dll.

He won nearly 50 awards in the Malaysian Bonsai Competition through his journey in Bonsai

He was the vice president of Persatuan Seniman Bonsai Malaysia and a member of Bonsai Club International, assistant secretary of Gushi and Penjing Art Association Kedah, Member of Malaysian Bonsai Sosial Society Kuala Lumpur, Member of Persatuan Penanam Bonsai Johor, as bonsai judges in many competition around the region.

He is writing a report on his massive collection of about 500 bonsai trees, which includes ext *Premna*, *Beackea Frutescens*, *buxus*, *Maba Buxifolia*, *Wrightia Religiosa*, *Hisbiscus*, *triphasia Tripholia*, *Murraya paniculata*, *Ficus*, and more.

His bonsai journey included approximately 50 awards in National Bonsai competitions and won many times overall champions in regional competitions, he was also appointed as a judge multiple times.

He promoted bonsai as vice president of Persatuan Seniman Bonsai Malaysia, a member of Bonsai Club International, assistant secretary of Gushi and Penjing Art Association Kedah, and a life member of Malaysia Bonsai Suiseki Society Kuala Lumpur and Persatuan Penanam Bonsai Johor.
